COVID-19 VACCINATION

SNAP has put together a comprehensive COVID-19 Vaccination policy. This policy can be viewed on our website, www.snaparts.org/programs. As a result of that policy, all people engaging in SNAP programs are required to be vaccinated. If you cannot be vaccinated because of a medical reason or sincerely held religious belief, you need to submit in writing a request for accommodation to the SNAP Executive Director, Heidi O'Mara. Vaccinated employees, contractors, participants, parents, caregivers and volunteers need to send a copy of their vaccination card before participating in programs. SNAP will maintain documentation regarding accommodations and vaccinations in a confidential manner. Requests for accommodation and vaccination card submissions can be sent to Ms. O'Mara at info@snaparts.org. Although we anticipate that most people will be vaccinated, for the few who, through special accommodation, are not, out of an abundance of caution, we are requiring ***ALL*** people to be masked.

MASKS

SNAP programs will take place at the Lexington Community Center. Based on the information we have now from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), masking indoors, even for vaccinated people, is encouraged. SNAP will require masks for everyone participating in-person in our programs at the Lexington Community Center.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

Based on current guidance from the CDC regarding indoor classroom-type spaces, SNAP staff and volunteers will work to maintain a socially distanced environment of three feet amongst participants, parents and caregivers. This will include arranging seating for both rehearsals and art classes at that is at least three feet apart.

HYGIENE AND HANDWASHING

Everyone participating in SNAP programs is encouraged to frequently wash their hands. Hand sanitizer will be available at SNAP rehearsals and art classes. Everyone should wash/sanitize their hands especially upon arrival to SNAP programs, before and after eating a snack, after bathroom use and after coughing or sneezing.

CLEANING AND DISINFECTING

The Lexington Community Center is committed to maintaining a safe and clean environment, including regular cleaning of high-touch areas, program space and equipment. SNAP staff and volunteers will disinfect program space and materials in between consecutively offered art classes.

These protocols are subject to change as new guidance becomes available.
